

# First Baptist Brandon Christian Academy COVID Guidelines

## If the Student or Employee Tests Positive for COVID



- Notify the Principal at (813) 689-9435.
- Student must self-quarantine for 10 days.



- Student testing positive for COVID-19 must self-quarantine for 10 days.
- Principal will contact necessary local agencies for next steps.
- Classroom will have a thorough cleaning as a precaution.
- Parents and teacher in the classroom will be notified as to what next steps are being recommended by local agencies. (Possible closure of classroom and or quarantine may be needed)



- After the 10 day quarantine period, if symptom free, the student may return to school .

## If a Member of the Household Tests Positive for COVID



- Notify the Principal at (813) 689-9435.
- Student must self-quarantine for 10 days. (See note #2 below)



- Principal will contact necessary local agencies to determine next steps.
- Classroom will have a thorough cleaning as a precaution.
- Classroom may remain open due to secondary exposure.



- Student may return to school after 10 days of self-quarantine. If symptom free.

## If a Student or Employee is Exposed to COVID Outside of the Household



- Notify the Principal at (813) 689-9435.
- If exposure occurs at school parent will be notified.



- Principal will contact necessary local agencies to determine next steps.
- Classroom will have a thorough cleaning as a precaution.
- Classroom may remain open due to secondary exposure.



**OPTION:**  
Parents/Employees may select either #1 or #2 below

1. Student may return to school after 10 days of self-quarantine if symptom free.
2. Student/Employees may remain in school if they show no evidence of COVID over a 10-day period. If symptoms do develop, then they will need to quarantine for 10 days from onset of symptoms or until cleared by a medical doctor.

### NOTES:

1. Potential Exposure: A potential exposure means being in a household or having close contact (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes) with an individual with confirmed COVID-19.
2. 7 day quarantine: A student/employee may return to school after an exposure to COVID if they test negative on a PCR test. Test should occur no earlier than day 6 after exposure.
